Few Slots Remain for 4-Hour Karting Enduro
THE DRIVE FOR 75, The Race To End Homelessness

Wheaton, IL (May 27, 2016) Continental Motors Group of Naperville and DuPagePads have teamed up again for the sixth annual karting enduro for charity. Up to fifteen teams will compete in raising money for DuPagePads mission to end homelessness with a goal of reaching \$75,000 by race day. This year's race will take place on Sunday, June 26th from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at Autobahn Country Club in Joliet, IL.

Over the past 5 years this event has raised over \$400,000, all going toward housing programs and support services for those who are homeless.

Space is limited to 15 participating teams and only a few spots remain. Participants are asked to give their all in helping achieve the \$75,000 goal. The minimum fundraising goal per team is \$2,500 and to reach this goal they are given their own fundraising webpage to make collecting donations quick, secure and convenient.
