


# **Ending homelessness** in DuPage County.

# Who We Served (2018-2019)



100% served in DuPage County • 69% listed address in DuPage County

29% of the 1,205 people we served who were homeless obtained stable housing

**28%** served were families with children

# Interim (Overnight) Housing & Client Service Center

- 1,205 people served
- 38,989 nights of shelter provided
- 119,959 meals served for people who would otherwise go hungry, an average of 329 meals a day

### **Supportive Housing**

- 82% have had a place to call home for a year or longer.
- 122 apartments provided for individuals, families and veterans in Supportive Housing; 157 individuals including 30 children.
- Supportive Housing units saved taxpayers more than \$3 million.

### **Housing Now**

 Rapidly rehouses households with income by providing rent assistance and ongoing case management.



67 served in 24 households;
 100% of households maintained housing.

**63%** of clients reported having at least one chronic health condition



### **Medical Respite Program**

- Short-term housing for those who are homeless and need bed rest.
- 98 individuals served in 61 households; 46% of households are now in stable housing or have a housing plan.



**151** were served, including **93** children.

### **Family Outreach**

- Comprehensive support services to families not consistently using the overnight sites.
- 151 served, including 93 children in 44 households; 70% of households are now in stable housing.

#### Street Outreach

- 50 served; 32% exited to emergency or stable housing


### **Career Employment Solutions**

- Partnering with 150 local employers in various industries to hire our clients.
- 194 individuals served; 64% obtained employment
