

Hired on the Spot: DuPagePads 2nd Annual Career Fair Success

More than 200 job seekers attended DuPage**Pads** 2nd Annual Career Fair on June 19 at College of DuPage, a 67% increase over last year's inaugural event. This year's new venue hosted 35 local employers looking to hire with free admission and free parking.

35 DuPage**Pads** program participants attended the event and while results are still coming in, one DuPage**Pads** client was hired on the spot, two more were hired as a result of attending the Career Fair and six clients have upcoming interviews.

Nickea, a DuPage**Pads** client, shared, "This Career Fair provided wonderful opportunities for advancement. I'm now optimistic for my future."

To help prepare our participants for the Career Fair, DuPage**Pads** hosted several workshops leading up to the event. These valuable workshops provided:

- Makeup, manicures and hair styling
- Networking techniques
- Finishing touches on resumes
- Creative writing classes
- Mock interviews

"I am writing to thank your organization for the outstanding work that you do. I saw firsthand how generosity and compassion can encourage someone with little or no hope, to envision a future for himself.

My son, Charles found himself homeless and in trouble with the law, after I retired and moved to Mississippi. To make a long story short, he was given probation instead of jail time and ended up at DuPage**Pads**.

He was unable to get a job on his own or with anyone else's help for over 3 years. However, under the guidance of DuPagePads Career Employment Program, he got a job that he was proud to have.

He spoke to me every night from the homeless shelter. He was amazed at the quality of the meals provided every night and how nice everybody at your organization was. He was just so grateful for everything that was done for him.

Charles died May 14, 2016.

After his passing, I went to DuPage**Pads** to meet Carlos and Lutisha and thank them for helping my son. He spoke so highly of them and everyone else.

I just donated and will for years to come. I read some of the stories on your website and was brought to tears because I know how grateful those people are.
