- **\$100** can provide 20 prescription co-payments.
- **\$250** can provide diapers and formula for a baby for one month.
- **\$500** can provide monthly train passes for five individuals during the first month of employment.
- **\$1,000** can provide job coaching and computer training for 16 individuals.
- **\$2,500** can provide housing for a family for three months.
- **\$5,000** can provide interim (overnight) housing and support services for a family for one year.

### Last year DuPagePads:

Provided **44,284** nights of shelter.

Served **145,501** meals, an average of **399** meals a day.

Assisted our neighbors: **71%** of those served listed their last address in DuPage County.

Assisted **107** individuals in obtaining employment; **63%** remaining employed for over 90 days.

Partnered with more than **4,000** volunteers and **160** congregations who donated over **65,000** hours last year, the equivalent of **31** full-time employees.

Assisted **392** individuals in obtaining housing.



## Perma-Seal’s Donation Provides Storage Solution for DuPagePads

DuPage**Pads** was awarded a grant from Perma-Seal to waterproof, purify, safeguard and protect the basement and foundation in our Employment and Education building at 705 West Liberty in Wheaton.

Prior to Perma-Seal’s assistance, the basement experienced frequent water seepage and constant dampness. Over the last couple of years, these issues became progressively worse. The primary function of the basement is to store critical donations for families and individuals who are homeless. Items include diapers, personal care items and pads for sleeping.



The Employment and Education building contains office space for program staff and also houses our computer lab, used by participants to research and apply for job positions.

In June, Perma-Seal began work on the basement and foundation. All of the updates were completed by early September, and the basement is now dry with healthy air quality.

“As you can imagine, the benefits of Perma-Seal’s assistance with this needed capital project has gone a long way to improve the services we provide,” said Carol Simler, DuPage**Pads**’ President & CEO. **“On behalf of all DuPagePads staff, participants and visitors, we are truly grateful for Perma-Seal’s solution.”**



## Angela’s Story

### “DuPagePads Helped Me Focus on the Positive”

Losing her job and her apartment soon after, Angela had no family left in the area and began staying at the DuPage**Pads** Interim (overnight) Housing sites.

Angela was referred to DuPage**Pads** Employment and Education Program which helped her fine tune her resume and search for career opportunities. “Sometimes I got so involved in job searching that I would lose track of time and stay till the computer lab closed,” Angela added.

Once she obtained an interview, her DuPage**Pads** Employment Specialist made sure she had suits and clothes to help her feel confident. Thanks to her hard work and perseverance, and the help of DuPage**Pads**, Angela now has a job in finance resolution in Oak Brook.

Angela is excited about moving into her new apartment in Westmont. She says, “I love deciding where to put things and what color to paint the accent wall.” She has also been able to unload the heavy purse that she needed to use. “Now I just carry my wallet and keys!”



“To me, DuPage**Pads** means a new beginning, a stepping stone into a new life.” Angela admits to learning a lot about herself during the process of finding a new job and place to live. She says, “If you think positive, positive comes; if you think negative, negative comes. DuPage**Pads** helped me focus on the positive.”

## DuPagePads 10th Annual Run 4 Home: A Record-Breaking Finish!

On Saturday, September 6th DuPage**Pads** held the 10th Annual Run 4 Home 5K & 10K Run, 5K Walk in Wheaton. DuPage**Pads** welcomed the largest participation in its ten year history and raised more than \$130,000 to help the organization’s goal to end homelessness in DuPage County.

Top sponsors included Continental Motors of Naperville, Republic Bank, and Mike Lifts 100 Tons; a new fundraiser where Mike DeMeritt collected donations to lift 100 tons in less than eight hours.

Runners raced to the top of a hill a half mile into the race to be crowned “King of the Hill,” an honor given to the first male and female runners to reach the peak. Participants gathered together after their trek to acknowledge the top performers in fundraising, racing and participation.

The real winners of the race are the families and individuals who were homeless and will now obtain housing, support services and employment which leads to improved health and economic sustainability as a result of funds raised from the event.
