


Ending homelessness in DuPage County.

330
individuals served obtained permanent housing.

Interim (Overnight) Housing & Client Service Center

- 1,001 people served
- 37,744 nights of shelter provided
- 119,912 meals served for people who would otherwise go hungry, an average of 329 meals a day

Supportive Housing

- 87% have had a place to call home for a year or longer.
- 94 apartments provided for individuals, families and veterans in Supportive Housing; 163 individuals including 43 children.
- Supportive Housing units saved taxpayers \$2.4 million.

Housing Now

 Rapidly rehouses households with income by providing rent assistance and ongoing case management.



39 served in 23 households; 100% of households maintained housing. **47%** of clients reported having at least one chronic health condition



Medical Respite Program

- Short-term housing for those who are homeless and need bed rest.
- 85 individuals served in 60 households; 58% of households are now in stable housing or have a housing plan.



179 were served, including **108** children.

Family Outreach

- Comprehensive support services to families not consistently using the overnight sites.
- 179 served, including 108 children in 56 households; 68% of households are now in stable housing.

Street Outreach

- 52 served; 38% exited to emergency or stable housing


Career Employment Solutions

- Partnering with 124 local employers in various industries to hire our clients.
- 191 individuals served; 68% obtained employment
